# CHANGED TRAFFIC CONDITIONS ON OLYMPIC HIGHWAY **BETWEEN COOTAMUNDRA AND YOUNG:**

Motorists are advised of changed traffic conditions from next week on the Olympic Highway for drainage improvement work Crowe (Soccer Fields) & then progress to Owen Vincent. to be carried out between Cootamundra and Young. Single lane closures will be in place at three locations along the highway to provide a stronger and safer road for motorists. Work will be carried out between 7am and 6pm from Tuesday 22 August to Thursday 30 November, weather permitting. Work at one location will be finished before starting work at the next site, with each site to take about 3-4 weeks to finish, weather permitting.

Over size, over mass vehicles will be assisted through the site by traffic control. Access to properties will be always maintained. Motorists are advised to drive to the conditions and follow the directions of signs and traffic control. Transport for NSW thanks motorists for their patience during this time. # **ILLEGAL DUMPING:**

Council has seen an increase in items being left on the footpath at charity stores. Council wishes to remind members of the public that leaving donations out the front of the Charity Stores is illegal dumping and Council may issue fines for leaving anything outside of the stores. Donations to any charity store can only be made when the store is open and willing to accept the goods.

#### MUTTAMA CREEK DESCRIPTION OF WORKS:

Permit to conduct maintenance works within Cootamundra Shire has been approved by DPI Fisheries and Crown Land. Permit allows desilting and vegetation removal maximum 10m upstream and downstream of drainage structures located within the creek (e.g. Bridges, culverts and causeways). Current focus is within Cootamundra township with plans to move on to Stockinbingal in the coming months as program allows. Current works are to encourage creek flows past and through structures as originally designed. This will allow further investigation into how the creek channel levels have changed due to sediment build up and allow for an accurate scope of works to be developed to address the current issues with the creek.
