LOCAL HERITAGE GRANTS:

A local heritage grant program has been established by Cootamundra-Gundagai Regional Council (CGRC) with the aid of funding from support from NSW Government. The aim of the program is to encourage the conservation of heritage items within the Cootamundra-Gundagai Regional Council Local Government Area (LGA) and promote a positive community attitude to heritage conservation. Payment of grants will not be made until the project is complete and a final report from Council's Heritage Advisor is received. Applicants will be required to provide at least matching finance for the projects. Applications for the Local Heritage Grants 2023/2024 are now open and close – 5pm Monday 16 October 2023.
