NOTIFICATION OF RABBIT BAITING PROGRAM -STOCKINBINGAL CEMETERY:

Council in conjunction with Local Lands Services will be undertaking a rabbit baiting program at the Stockinbingal Cemetery in the coming weeks. Between Monday 23rd October to Monday 30th October 2023, green dyed chopped carrots containing the anticoagulant poison Pindone will be used at baiting stations within the Cemetery.

Poisons pose an extreme risk to your livestock and domestic animals. Please take steps (e.g., restraint or muzzling) to make sure your animals do not have access to the baits or affected animals. The program is undertaken as per the Pesticide Control (Pindone Products) Order 2010. The pesticide is lethal to dogs and cats and if consumed can cause illness to humans. Contact your local vet or seek medical advice in the case of suspected poisoning.
