GUNDAGAI VILLAGES FLOOD STUDY (COOLAC, NANGUS, TUMBLONG AND DARBALARA):

Council has been successful in receiving grant funding to undertake a flood study for the villages of Coolac, Nangus, Tumblong and Darbalara. The first task of a flood study is to form a Floodplain Risk Management Committee. The Committee is formed to act as an advisory committee to the Council under the guidelines specified by the NSW Floodplain Development Manual. Committee membership is made from a mixture of representatives including elected Council members, Council staff, SES, Government agency and community representation. Expressions of interest are now invited for community members to form part of the Gundagai Villages Floodplain Risk Management Committee. If you are interested in becoming a community member of the committee, please submit your letter of application to mail@cgrc.gov.nsw.au or over the counter at either the Gundagai or Cootamundra offices Your application must include detail of your interest and why you would like to join the committee. 

(MOU) BETWEEN MEMBER COUNCILS AND BALD HILL QUARRY:

South West Regional Waste Group (SWRWG) made up of Cootamundra Gundagai Regional Council, Hilltops Council, Snowy Valleys Council and Yass Valley Councils has finalized the first draft of the revised Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between member Councils and Bald Hill Quarry. The MOU will set the Waste Management guidelines in cooperation. Between both parties to ensure the ongoing management of putrescible

waste throughout the region. The SWRWG has recently appointed a full time Waste Environmental Officer to assist member Councils in the management of the Waste Contract between SWRWG and Bald Hill Landfill.



The primary focus for the position is to ensure full compliance with the terms and conditions of the Contract and how member councils can work cohesively together to reduce waste to landfill, reduce operating costs and to develop effective and efficient reuse programs.

It is anticipated that the MOU will be adopted by member Councils December 2023.

ACCOUNTANT - COOTAMUNDRA

This position provides professional assistance to the Manager of Finance. This role is to co-ordinate and prepare financial documentation for review within defined strategic parameters and co-ordinates and oversees the functions of the Cootamundra finance team. The position will also include the field management of the Roads Maintenance Council Contract (RMCC) with TfNSW including resourcing of work, ensuring relevant standards are met, liaising with TfNSW Surveillance Officer and assisting with review of Defect Registers and Work Programs. Applications, addressed to the General Manager should be submitted by **5p.m. on Friday 8 December 2023.**
