GUNDAGAI VILLAGES FLOOD STUDY (COOLAC, NANGUS, TUMBLONG AND DARBALARA):

Council has been successful in receiving grant funding to undertake a flood study for the villages of Coolac, Nangus, Tumblong and Darbalara. The first task of a flood study is to form a Floodplain Risk Management Committee. The Committee is formed to act as an advisory committee to the Council under the guidelines specified by the NSW Floodplain Development Manual. Committee membership is made from a mixture of representatives including elected Council members, Council staff, SES, Government agency and community representation.

Expressions of interest are now invited for community members to form part of the Gundagai Villages Floodplain Risk Management Committee.
