### POSTION VACANT- ROAD SAFETY OFFICER:

The function of this role includes developing, implementing and promoting: Effective community road safety programs in conjunction with key stakeholders. This position is full time and currently co-funded between Council and TfNSW, up to 30 June 2025. Extension to this term will be subject to recurrent funding performance and operational requirements. Challenges in raising the profile of road safety in the community to guide behavioural change. 3. Prepare and implement a Local Road Safety 2022 Year Action Plan for Council with particular emphasis on projects that utilise the Safe Systems approach to road safety.
