OLYMPIC HIGHWAY ROAD WORKS NEAR WALLENDBEEN:

Pavement stabilisation will be performed on Olympic Highway and Burley Griffin Way within the Wallendbeen village area from Monday 29 January 2024 for approximately 3-4 days. The Wallendbeen rest area will be closed to all traffic during this time.

Olympic Highway culvert replacement works will commence Monday 5 February, north of Wallendbeen and continue for 6-7 weeks. All works under full traffic control. Expect short delays. Work schedules weather dependent.
