ROAD WORKS

Wallendbeen rest area closed until Friday 9 February 2024 to allow pavement works to be completed on Burley Griffin Way. Heavy Patching at Wallendbeen on Olympic Highway tomorrow. Olympic Highway culvert replacement works recommenced north of Wallendbeen and will proceed for 6-7 weeks. This area will remain under reduced speed 24/7 with steel safety barriers and night lights for motorist safety. Motorists are asked to adhere to reduced speeds in this area. Heavy patching along Burley Griffin Way between Hilltops Boundary and Stockinbingal over the next 2-3 weeks.

Resealing planned on Olympic Highway near Rotary Park, south of Cootamundra w/c 13 Feb. Rotary Park is temporarily closed and will also be bitumen sealed. Resealing town streets in Stockinbingal and Cootamundra currently being performed.
