Council hosted a Round Table conference in Gundagai on Monday 29 January to discuss the Financial Sustainability of Merged Councils, it was very well supported with all 47 delegates from NSW State Government, surrounding merged councils, Hilltops, Snowy Valley, Snowy Monaro, and Federation attending. Chaired by Mick Veitch from Council House, delegates were able to listen to presentations from Mr. Brett Whitworth **Deputy Secretary NSW Office of Local** Government, Darriea Turley AM, President Local Government NSW, Peter Tegart Always Thinking, Dr Amanda Cohn NSW Greens Spokesperson for Local Government, Jed Lawton United Services Union. Delegates had the opportunity for a Q & A session, and open forum. A full report on this conference will come later. In short, the consensus was that these forcibly merged councils are not working and there is a need to pursue a demerger process. CGRC is continuing to work through the pathway set down by the Minister for Local Government and more will come on our progress soon.
