ROAD WORKS ON BURLEY GRIFFIN WAY AT STOCKINBINGAL:

Transport for NSW is planning to carry out road resurfacing work on the Burley Griffin Way to provide a safer and smoother road between Stockinbingal and Wallendbeen. A 2.5-kilometre section of the Burley Griffin Way will be resurfaced. Working between Stockinbingal Road and Yeo Yeo Road from Monday 26 February to Tuesday 30 April 2024, weather permitting. Work hours are between 7am and 6pm Monday to Saturday. Motorists should plan their journey and allow an extra five minutes' travel time.
