

FROM THE MAYOR:

I hope everyone had a lovely and safe Easter. Council resolved at the extraordinary meeting held Tuesday 19 March to present Detailed Transitional Plan (DTP) and Financial Sustainability Plan (FSP) to the Minister for Local Government.

These plans were taken to Sydney last week and are the pathways CGRC and the two new Councils will follow to achieve financial sustainability and deliver services expected by our communities.

I urge all residents and ratepayers to read these plans so you are all informed on the implications of the proposed demerger of the current Council to the former Cootamundra and Gundagai Shire Councils.

I will be attending the Rural and Regional Summit in May along with two fellow councillors, this summit will include a review of the financial model for local government, case studies showcasing excellence in the rural and regional local government sector, panel discussions on the vision for rural and regional NSW, and updates from the NSW Reconstruction Authority.

I had the pleasure of opening the Cootamundra Youth Hub, alongside Member for Cootamundra Steph Cooke, this is a fantastic space for the youth of Cootamundra, and I hope that many will take advantage of the Hub, for homework space, catching up with friends and participating in activities.

The Seniors week activities across the region were a great success, all events had a great turn out and we have received loads of positive comments. It is heartwarming to the staff who organise these events to see them well supported and received.

DEMERGER NEWS:

Council adopted at an extraordinary meeting on 19 March 2024 to lodge Detailed Transition Plan (DTP) and Financial Sustainability Plan (FSP) prepared to demonstrate Councils ability to demerge and form two separate Councils, (Cootamundra Council and Gundagai Council) to the Minister for Local Government the Hon Ron Hoenig MP. Council will develop and deliver a communications plan designed to inform the community of the details within the plans, the financial and social impacts associated with the demerger and to assist the community in understanding the longterm sustainability goals of both new councils following demerger. The DTP and FSP are the pathways CGRC, and the two new Councils will follow to achieve the financial sustainability whilst maintaining the level of services the community expect. The profiles of the proposed new councils (former Shires of Cootamundra and Gundagai) are somewhat different, resulting in the need for different interventions.

• Both Councils support roughly the same asset base with similar overheads. Gundagai has roughly half the rate revenue to that of Cootamundra.

• Substantial infrastructure upgrades such as the Sewage Treatment Plant and Sheridan Street upgrade in Gundagai contributes to increases in operating and maintenance costs.

All residents and rate payers are urged to read the reports. They will be available at the CGRC Administration offices in Cootamundra and Gundagai and on the CGRC website at <u>Demerger News</u> <u>Cootamundra Gundagai Regional</u> <u>Council (nsw.gov.au)</u>
