RE-ESTABLISHMENT OF ALCOHOL-FREE ZONES IN COOTAMUNDRA

Under Section 644 of the Local Government Act, Council is proposing to re-establish alcohol free zones in Parker St. between Mackay and O'Donnell Sts. Adams St. between Cooper Ln and Parker Ln, Parker Ln, between Wallendoon and Adams Sts. Cooper Ln between Wallendoon and Adams Sts. Wallendoon St. between Parker Ln and Hovell St, Hovell St between Wallendoon and Mackay Sts, and in Hovell Ln between Wallendoon and Mackay Sts. A copy of the map can be viewed on Council's website at www.cgrc.nsw.gov.au. Therefore, notice is hereby given under Section 644 of the Local Government Act that Council proposes to re-establish the above alcohol-free zones. If accepted after due process, it is intended to re-establish the alcohol-free zones for a further four-year period. A public consultation period applies to the establishment of alcohol-free zones, therefore interested parties are invited to make representations or objections about this proposal. These representations or objections must be received in writing by Council by Friday April 19 2024.
