

We're doing work in your area

CGRC wishes to inform all customers in Cootamundra that the water mains rehabilitation project will commence shortly in Ursula Street, Adam Street, Queen Street, and Hay Street. CGRC has engaged a contractor to undertake the project.

This is not just about pipes. It's about water clean, life-sustaining water. Our Work will ensure we can continue to provide a clean and reliable water supply. This project is a part of the annual mains replacement program and also to progress the asset renewal program identified in the Business Plan.

Time of Work

Our work is planned to commence on 22 April 2024 and, weather and ground conditions permitting, take about 20 weeks to complete.

Day Works

Our daytime work hours are 7 am to 5 pm, Monday to Friday and 8 am to 1 pm on Saturdays (if needed). We won't work on Sundays or on Public Holidays.

What is expected?

We know our work can be disruptive, so we will make every effort to reduce any impact our work may have on you. You may experience.

Impact on your service

Your water service may be temporarily interrupted at different stages of the project. If you are affected by the shutdown, you will receive a separate letter with more information.

Noise

During our work, there will be some noise from our plant and equipment (including a saw cutter and jackhammer) and machinery.

Traffic and parking changes

Our work will take up space on the road. Traffic controllers will help maintain traffic around our work areas while keeping you safe.

Some on-street parking will be temporarily unavailable during our work hours and overnight, but the contractor will let you know before we start so you can safely move your vehicle if required.

Temporary Laydown Areas

The contractor will establish two temporary laydown areas for this work. These areas will be used to store equipment, materials and amenities for the construction crew. The contractor may borrow some parking spaces on the street for the construction machinery and skip bins.

Maintaining driveway access

Access in and out of some driveways on Ursula Street, Adam Street, Queen Street and Hay Street may be limited at times. Our friendly construction crews will doorknock if you are impacted and help you in and out of your driveway if needed.

Restoration

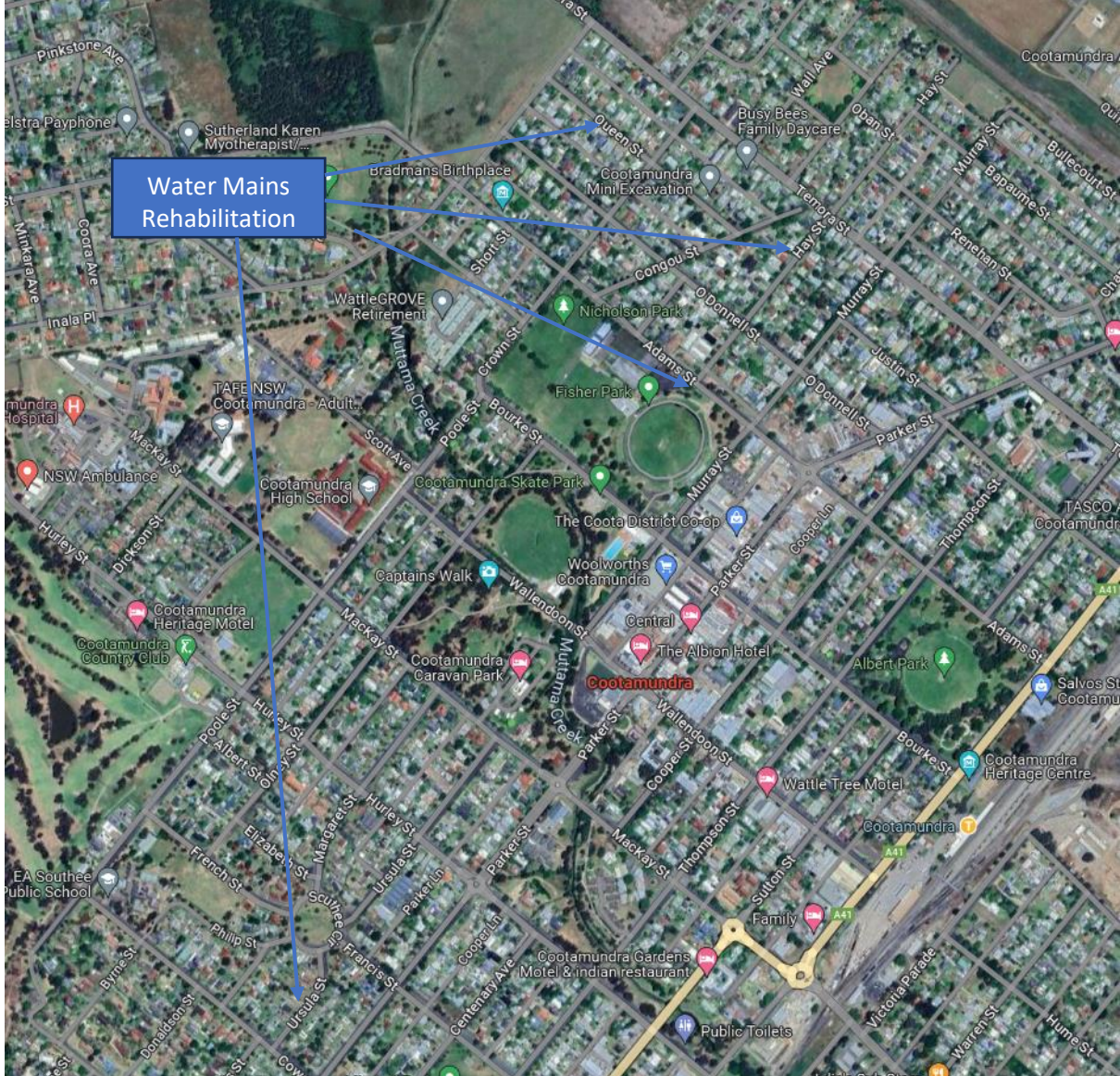
We will temporarily restore the road and verge to allow for continued use. When work is complete in all areas, a permanent restoration will commence.
