



GUNDAGAI SHERIDAN STREET UPGRADE:

Work commenced on Tuesday 14 May 2024. Parking will be restricted on the southern side of Sheridan Street between Homer St. and Gundagai Tyre and Auto Shop for the duration of the works. Traffic will be impacted on occasions throughout the works. Vehicles will need to follow traffic controllers and/or detour signs. Motorists are requested to obey traffic signals.

COOTAMUNDRA CIVIL WORKS:

Various Local Road Line Marking. Commencing Monday 20/05/2024 duration approximately one week. Expect minor delays on, Rosehill Road, Jugiong Road, Dirnaseer Road, Muttama Rd, Old Gundagai Rd, Stockingbingal Rd, Berthong Rd, North Berthong Rd and Parker St School Crossing Between Justin St and Temora St.

Hovell St Rehabilitation (FLR Round 4 Grant Funded). Between Olympic Hwy via Campbell St to Cowcumbra St, currently in design phase, expect service relocations to commence over coming months.

CHANGE OF TRAFFIC CONDITIONS

PARKER/WALLEDOON STREETS COOTAMUNDRA:

Motorists are advised that a High Pedestrian Activity Area (HPAA), is being implemented in Parker/Wallendoon Streets Cootamundra. The speed limit will be reduced to 30km/h in the town centre to make it a safe and welcoming place to visit, stay and shop. The new speed limit of 30km/h will be effected from 3 June 2024.

GARBAGE BIN PLACEMENT:

The CGRC Garbage trucks use an automated arm to collect the bins from the kerb. It is important that the bins are not blocked by vehicles or other obstructions that prevent the trucks arm from reaching the bins. Bins should open towards the street to prevent damage to the lid/can. Leave a minimum of one bin width between each bin and other objects. The best placement for a bin is at least 5 metres from the end of a driveway on level ground, to avoid blocking the driveway when bin is emptied and replaced. Always ensure the cans are visible for the driver to see and service. Times of collection can vary, please leave your bin out until it is collected.

ROADWORKS:

Shoulder, pavement and culvert works at Migurra Reserve on Olympic Highway continues for approx. 5-6 weeks. Full traffic management. Expect short delays. TfNSW project under Council management. Line marking to commence along Olympic Highway and Burley Griffin Way.
