CHANGE OF TRAFFIC CONDITIONS

PARKER/WALLEDOON STREETS COOTAMUNDRA:

Motorists are advised that a **High Pedestrian Activity Area (HPAA)**, is being implemented in Parker/Wallendoon Streets Cootamundra. The speed limit will be reduced to 30km/h in the town centre to make it a safe and welcoming place to visit, stay and shop. The new speed **limit of 30km/h will be effected from 3 June 2024.**

GARBAGE BIN PLACEMENT:

The CGRC Garbage trucks use an automated arm to collect the bins from the kerb. It is important that the bins are not blocked by vehicles or other obstructions that can prevent the trucks arm from easily reaching the cans. Bins should open towards the street to prevent damage to the lid/can. **Leave a minimum of one bin width** between each bin and other objects. The best placement for a bin is at least 5 metres from the end of a driveway on level ground, to avoid blocking the driveway when bin is emptied and replaced. Always ensure the cans are visible for the driver to see and service. Times of collection can vary, please leave your bin out until it is collected.
