Club Background

The Cootamundra Bridge Club has been in existence for many years and has operated very successfully with few members.

Current Club

Approximately 13 to 14 years ago the game of Bridge saw a revival in Cootamundra with many new players learning the game and joining the Club. There are regular lessons conducted by a very capable Bridge teacher for new players and those players wishing to improve their game. The Club now has approx 70 members who are also registered players with the Australian Bridge Federation. As well as Cootamundra residents, players come regularly from Gundagai, Harden, and Junee.

At present the Club has 2 sessions per week - Tuesday mornings and Thursday afternoons.

The Club has also established its own website over the last 2 years.

As the club does not own their own premises a room is hired at Cootamundra Country Club for these sessions and members fees cover the hire costs.

Club Future

The Cootamundra Bridge Club looks very strong and is continuing to grow.

Benefits of the Bridge Club

The social benefits of the Club are immeasurable in that the Bridge days provide a great network for all players to get together and enjoy the game of Bridge. The mental health advantages of our Bridge Club are very highly rated from the medical fraternity.

Congress

The Cootamundra Bridge Club is proposing to conduct a Congress in September 2023 when it is expected that approximately 80 – 100 players will play. Many of these players will be from out-of- town. The last Congress was held approximately 20 years ago except for a trial congress held last year.

This year the players will come from all over NSW as well as ACT and Victoria. They will stay a minimum of 2 nights in Cootamundra with many staying 3 nights. It is anticipated that all accommodation will be in town which will be an economic benefit to motels and food outlets.

To conduct a Congress a State Director must be used to actually run the play on the 2 days. This involves setting the cards, doing all scoring and adjudicating any problems players have during rounds of play. The Director will charge a fee of approximately \$1,200 plus accommodation costs for the weekend which will be 3 nights.

The Congress will be held at the Cootamundra Ex-Services Club in the Auditorium and there are charges for the hire of the room for the 2 days.

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Other expenses are for the prizes which must be quite substantial to encourage players to come and play.

Players will be charged an entry fee to compete and to cover meals and incidentals.

Additional Funding Request

The Cootamundra Bridge Club is requesting financial assistance from our local Cootamundra-Gundagai Regional Council to help run the event.

The amount requested is \$2,000 which should cover the Director's fees and costs, as well as supplying and dealing of cards for the weekend.

If Council sees fit to assist the Bridge Club with this amount, the congress will be assured to be very successful and a benefit financially and socially to Cootamundra.

NAIDOC WEEK 2023 - 2ND - 9TH July



Firstly, we would like to convey our appreciation for the support that has been provided the initiatives in previous years. It is only through the dedicated partnerships that we can receive such a vast and creative response to the initiatives from students across the LGA.

The 2022 NAIDOC Week School initiatives have again proven to be an overwhelming success. The positive feedback received from many principals and teachers was overwhelming; "Thank you for providing the opportunity for the students to engage in the 2022 NAIDOC School Initiatives", "It is enlightening for our students to participate and gain further knowledge through the NAIDOC School Initiatives".

The initiatives annually bring out the best creativity of school students. We are taking the opportunity through our secondary creative initiative this year to ask students to design a poster for a local newspaper advertising a NAIDOC event in their own community, that could involve either their local council, Aboriginal Land Council, or other Indigenous organisation.

successful and last year was no
exception which produced over
201,111 entries from schools who
participated in a variety of
competitions, and we are



delighted to announce the "2023 NAIDOC Week" Colouring-in/short story and Creative/Essay writing Competitions. Entry is open to all primary and secondary school students in communities.

The aim of these initiatives is to provide our kids with a greater understanding on the importance of friendship and cultural diversity. The competitions reflect Aboriginal ancestry and promote the growth of positive attitudes in all students towards Aboriginal people. They are broadly based around each year's national NAIDOC theme. The colouring-in/ Short-Story competitions are open to all primary school students and the Creative Art / Essay Writing competitions are open to all secondary students. The winning students are each year awarded prizes and or NAIDOC Medals of Excellence.

As part of National NAIDOC Week celebrations Koori Kids coordinates, with the support of various government departments and local councils an educational component to provide a link of cultural diversity to our kids with the NAIDOC Week School Initiative Competitions. These competitions have been a successful part of NAIDOC Week and to date we have received over 3,240,142 entries which include colouring-in, short story, creative art, and essay writing. As a result, we have awarded over 605 major prizes including Computers,

Televisions, Mountain Bikes, XBox consoles, DVD Players, MP3 Players, Mini Stereos, and Encyclopedia's. We have presented some 6650 encouragement awards including CDS, DVDS, Movie Tickets and certificates to all participants

This year our highlighted Indigenous role models include a broader spectre recognising Indigenous talent in entertainment and sport and their contribution to the national identity Jessica Mauboy (Indigenous Singer) and Josh Ado Carr (Indigenous sportsman). Our message this year is that education is knowledge and knowledge is GOLD

The logistics of the initiatives involve packages being sent to all school principals inviting students to participate in the competitions. Prizes will be awarded to the winning students along with the "NAIDOC Medal of Excellence" The Prime Minister has annually provided a message of support for the initiatives encouraging students to participate. "The wonderful work of student winners – and indeed all entrants – gives me great confidence for the future and our ability to forge a more united, harmonious and respectful future together in the spirit of reconciliation. We can draw inspiration from their idealism and creativity, and their instinctive sense of possibility and openness to change. That is why I am so delighted to be associated with the successful NAIDOC Week School Initiatives"

The judging of entries last year was adjudicated by a panel including our patron, Aboriginal Elders and Sponsoring agency delegates. The judging this year will take a similar precedent. At an awards presentation held during NAIDOC Week the Minister praised the competitions and their purpose "The initiative we are here to celebrate today provides a perfect illustration of how public awareness has been raised around these issues in recent times. The NAIDOC School Initiative competitions are a perfect opportunity to bring Australians together. They have clearly done so".

We acknowledge and appreciate the support of the council last year and seek your involvement again to maintain this year's competitions. We are asking that you assist this year by preparing a report to council and continuing your support to the initiative with a \$500.00 contribution towards printing and distribution for students within councils LGA. Support last year was recognised by the Prime Minister and Minister – Indigenous Affairs at the NAIDOC Awards presentation held during NAIDOC Week. Each year Koori Kids conducts the NAIDOC Week School Initiative Competitions for school aged children. This is broken up into primary and secondary school categories being colouring-in, short story writing and creative and essay writing. Koori Kids is seeking continued support from council and request consideration of council to be an associate partner with a \$500 contribution towards the program

Purpose

The purpose of this annexure to the proposal is to inform council of the Koori Kids 2023 School Initiatives program. The initiatives are coordinated in partnership with the Department of Education, Skills & Employment, NSW Department of Education, Department of Health, Transport for NSW, NSW Health, Catholic Schools NSW, and Department of Premier & Cabinet.

Koori Kids has provided a proposal and draft entry forms for the 2023 initiatives. The contribution sought (\$500) will be utilised towards the costs for printing and distribution of information packs, posters, and entry forms to schools across councils LGA. Council is acknowledged through logo inclusion as an associate partner on information packs sent to schools throughout councils LGA. If there is a winner from a school within council LGA, an invitation for the Mayor and or a representative is invited to attend the school, along with Executive Director, NAIDOC Week Initiatives, Director, Social Wellbeing and other dignitaries to make special presentation of the NAIDOC Medal of Excellence and the student's prize. (30+ NAIDOC Medals of Excellence are issued across the state). Media release for the winning school is prepared in consultation with council's media officer. Council is also forwarded a final report.

Conclusion

The NAIDOC Week School Initiatives are the only activity throughout NAIDOC Week that provides students with an educational component to NAIDOC Week and Indigenous culture and heritage. Our research and statistics confirm that schools within councils LGA are participating in the initiatives with increased participation from both state and catholic-independent schools.



Community Donations Application

Describe the activity/event and the justification for Council support

The Gundagai Business Network (GBN) commenced its Drop in Drinks evenings for business owners and their staff, in June 2022. These are informal evenings designed to get businesses together to get to know each other, discuss issues and opportunities and create a like minded business community that has one main goal - to grow Gundagai. This year, we would like to invite guest speakers to these events to cover topics that may assist further in ideas sharing and creating opportunities for our local businesses.

The GBN surveyed the business community in early 2023, regarding the support they would like from the Network. The overwhelming response was networking with other businesses (ie continuing our Drop in Drinks events), as well as education in the form of training sessions on specific subjects like digital marketing, customer service, and business planning.

GBN requests funding to assist with both the expenses associated with guest speakers at our Drop in Drinks evenings, and trainers for our training sessions. In addition, these events will require us to hire an event space, provide refreshments and advertise the events. Whilst our business community has advised they would be willing to pay for training, we would see this as a nominal fee and not something that would require a significant investment on their behalf.

Where and when will the activity/event be held?

It is our aim in 2023 to rotate the location of our Drop in Drinks by asking local businesses to host an event at their premises. This will help showcase our local businesses to the rest of the business community and will also provide an opportunity for the host business to seek feedback on their business from other like-minded businesses. We would propose running our Drop in Drinks events once a quarter (four times per year).

Regarding the location of the training sessions, again, this will depend on the type of training we are offering and the equipment our trainers need. Our options are somewhat limited though in terms of access to WIFI, catering, seating etc. Our thoughts are that most sessions will be held at the Gundagai Services Club. We would hope to conduct three to four training sessions this year.

How many Gundagai residents will participate in the event?

We currently have a database of 96 local businesses and community groups, with that number growing regularly. Obviously numbers will be limited on certain training sessions, however, we would expect between 20 and 40 people to attend our Drop in Drinks and training events.

How will this activity/event benefit the Cootamundra-Gundagai community?

Gundagai's businesses have been requesting support for some time, in the form of accessing training and networking opportunities. The GBN was formed in 2022 to help facilitate this, and to bring the business community closer together in order to build and grow Gundagai. Without a flourishing business community that feels supported and connected, we fear falling into what many towns are facing, with business

closures and a stagnant local economy. Tourism and economic development work hand in hand. Without one we cannot have the other, and our businesses - especially those in our central business district - are the face of our town.

How will the requested donation be spent?

The requested monies will be spent on trainer fees, training workbooks, room hire, catering, and marketing of the sessions including local advertising.







In more recent times the facility has been used for the annual rodeo, roping events, barrel racing, horseman ship clinics and gymkhanas. It attracts crowds in excess of a thousand people at a time which are made up of local competitors and members that travel from hundreds of kilometres away. We were also privileged to attract Bucking Bulls Australia and KRanch to hire our grounds to run their events in the past few months. These events bring their following, many tourists and travellers into our town who use accommodation, rural supply stores, food and beverage venues, fuel stations, and other smaller stores which is great for our district.

The current committee is family orientated team of volunteers, and has been formed by local people who are passionate about the long term future of the grounds, and its growth. Many of them compete in the sport of rodeo and have interests in the younger generation coming along behind them who will gain great benefit and stability of the improved facilities if they can be achieved.
