## A step-by-step guide to effective waste management



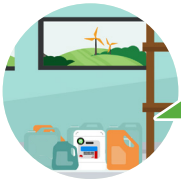
1 Rinse the drum with water immediately after use. If using Chemical Rinsing Bins hold the drum on the spigot until the water runs clean. If pressure rinsing, rinse until water runs clean



2 Pour any rinse water back into the spray tank and check the drum inside and out for residue. If residue is present rinse until residue free.



3 Remove lids and remove the metal handles from buckets. Allow to dry.



4 Store drums in safe area to ensure they remain dry prior to delivery.



5 Run your drums into your nearest **drumMUSTER** Collection Site. See page over for details.
