GESTURE FOR BIN TRIM PROJECT:

Member for Cootamundra Steph Cooke MP delivered a Community Recognition Statement to the NSW Parliament, highlighting the success of REROC's Circular Organics in the Eastern Riverina project. Gundagai's Niagara Café, McDonalds and Gundagai Hospital were recognised in the Statement acknowledging their contribution to the project & helping tackle the waste challenges by contributing to a better environment & supporting sustainable practices. The project encouraged food-related businesses to divert organic waste to FOGO bins for collection & processing into high-quality compost. Funded as an initiative by the NSW Environmental Protection Authority (EPA) the project recognises that organic waste in the green waste improves its decomposition & the resulting compost can be used by Council on public land, sporting fields, parks & gardens. Ms Cooke extended her congratulations to these organisations for their commitment to reducing landfill. A spokesperson from REROC expressed his appreciation to CGRC staff members for their valuable support in delivering the project locally.

Rehabilitation works on West Street are well underway, with the first stage & second stages complete. New kerb & guttering has been installed. (Pictured right). The rehabilitation project of the street included milling, stabilising & sealing of the road surface to rectify the failing pavement issues & other road defects. West Street will be a far safer road for motorists and pedestrians & ongoing maintenance issues addressed.

The brochure is available at administration offices & libraries, it gives some prompts to assist with reducing the risk of burglary, scamming & home security.



The new VMS boards use the latest LED technology to show text, graphics, animations & come with built in radar detection.
