COMPANION ANIMAL REGISTRY AUDIT 2025:

CGRC Rangers are working on updating the NSW Companion Animal Register for 2025. Cat & dog owners are required under the NSW Companion Animals Act 1998 to ensure their animals are identified (microchipped) & registered. **Microchipping is not the same as registration.**

Pet registration is important as owners are complying with the law but also contributing to a safety & a more pet friendly community. Registered pets are more easily identified if they are lost & the funds collected from registration fees are put towards community facilities & animal welfare services.

Community members may receive a letter in the upcoming month regarding this audit. The letter may request that they register their companion animals, or they will need to notify Council if an animal is no longer at the property or of any changed details. Registration can be paid at the CGRC Administration offices.
