NOTIFICATION OF RABBIT BAITING PROGRAM - STOCKINBINGAL CEMETERY

CGRC in conjunction with Local Lands Services will be undertaking a rabbit baiting program at the Stockinbingal Cemetery between **Mon 4 Aug to Fri 1 Sept 2025**, green dyed chopped carrots containing the anticoagulant poison Pindone will be used at baiting stations within the Cemetery. Poisons pose an extreme risk to your livestock & domestic animals. Please take steps (e.g. restraint or muzzling) to make sure your animals do not have access to the baits or affected animals. The pesticide Pindone is lethal to dogs & cats & if consumed can cause illness to humans. For more information contact 1300 459 689.

Residents are invited to attend a community consultation drop-in centre at the Stephen Ward Rooms on **Wed 13 Aug from 3pm to 6pm**. The drop-in centre is an opportunity for residents/stakeholders to review the current flood warning system for Cootamundra & recommend improvements for subsequent implementation. This is aimed at increasing the effectiveness of the flood warning system & reducing the risk to life & property within Cootamundra township.

FOOTPATH CLOSED SHERIDAN STREET GUNDAGAI:

Be advised the footpath adjacent to the Visitor Information Centre will be closed to allow for new works to take place.

Between Jul 2015 & Jun 2025 there have been 66 collisions between trains & road vehicles at level crossings in NSW, resulting in 9 fatalities & 9 serious injuries.
