MUTTAMA CREEK DRAFT **MASTERPLAN ON DISPLAY NOW**

The Draft Masterplan for Muttama Creek in Cootamundra has been prepared in conjunction with proposed flood mitigation works, ecological assessment and preliminary community consultation. The Master Plan will provide a framework to revitalise the riparian corridor, integrate flood mitigation, and create a sustainable open space ecological network within the town centre of Cootamundra.

There are four distinct character precincts along the 2km length of Muttama Creek.

MAJOR PROJECT - BETTS STREET **SEWAGE PUMPING STATION**

The Betts Street Sewage Pumping Station (SPS) Rising Main Replacement project will commence mid-end September, weather and ground conditions permitting. The proposed alignment travels through O'Connor Park, Strikers Lane, Gundagai Road.

The work will ensure Council can continue to provide a reliable and consistent sewerage services.

Work hours are 7 am to 5 pm, Monday to Friday, (except public holidays).

Access in and out of some driveways on Strikers Lane, Gundagai Road, and O'Connor Park may be limited at times. These residents will be informed and assisted if required.
