SEWAGE PUMP STATION REPLACEMENT PROJECT:

CGRC wishes to inform all customers in Cootamundra that the Betts Street Sewage Pumping Station (SPS) Rising Main Replacement project has commenced. As part of essential infrastructure works, Trazlat Pty Ltd has been engaged by Council to carry out construction works on Cowcumbra St Cootamundra. **Cowcumbra Street will be closed to through traffic from 7 Oct 2025 to 30 Oct 2025**, weather & site conditions permitting. A detour will be in place during this period. Local access will be maintained under the guidance of traffic controllers; driveway access may be temporarily restricted at times, with affected residents notified directly in advance.
