A severe storm passed over the LGA on Sunday 26 October, causing damage to trees and infrastructure. Council teams have been busy cleaning up downed trees and branches in streets and sporting fields in Cootamundra and Gundagai. *Pictured right:* Three shade sails at the Gundagai Swimming Pool were torn from fixings in the violent windstorm. The plant shed and pool handrails have sustained damage. The clean-up will involve the removal of the three permanent shade sails and repairs to the plant shed and handrails and will delay the opening by one week. The anticipated opening will be **8 November.**

NEVER BIN A BATTERY:

CGRC is reminding residents to dispose of batteries at dedicated battery recycling bins after two fires at the Cootamundra Landfill Facility recently.

Battery disposal points are located at supermarkets, Council admin offices and Community Recycling Centres in Cootamundra and Gundagai.

The incidents of fires in waste materials are on the increase.

Other common ignition sources include:

- Batteries, especially lithium-ion (from vapes, phones, laptops, power tools)
- Computers, mobile phones etc.
- Aerosol cans, particularly if not fully empty
- Gas bottles like BBQ or camping canisters
- Containers that held flammable liquids, such as paint thinners or solvents

Please be mindful of what you throw in your garbage bin. Put simply, it prevents dangers such as garbage truck fires from happening and keeps people safe.
