VILLAGE WASTE TRANSFER STATIONS – GUNDAGAI AREA
Residents with tag access must follow these guidelines:
Access: Use your allocated electronic tag. New/replacement tags are available at Council's Gundagai office (fees may apply).
Accepted Waste: Domestic waste and recycling only. No white goods, electrical items, batteries, silage wrap, fencing, or commercial waste. Commercial waste must go to Gundagai Burra Road Waste Depot.
Recycling: Sort waste and recycling before delivery. Do not include hazardous items like batteries or chemicals.
Collection Days: Tumblong & Nangus: Mondays. Coolac & Muttama: Wednesdays. Do not leave waste outside bins when full. Non-compliance may result in fines or access cancellation.
