



ORDINARY COUNCIL MEETINGS:

COOTAMUNDRA ROADS:

Heavy patching roadworks will be undertaken in the Cootamundra area from **2 February 2026**. Expected completion early April 2026. Please drive to the conditions, obey traffic signals & expect short delays.

GUNDAGAI RESIDENTS: LEVEL 2 WATER RESTRICTIONS:

Level 2 water restrictions in Gundagai are now being implemented.

- Fixed hoses and sprinklers banned between restriction times – 9am to 6pm
- Fixed hoses and sprinklers to be on a timer
- Washing of vehicles on lawns with a hose permitted provided the use a trigger cut off nozzle
- Hosing of paths and driveways banned
- Water runoff onto roads or gutters banned

Please note:

Stage 3 Water restrictions may be implemented into the future if the storage in Blowering and Burrinjuck Dams fall below 20% or water allocation is reduced to 50%.

OLYMPIC HIGHWAY ROADWORKS:

CGRC will be replacing two culverts on Olympic Highway just south of Cootamundra (one either side of the Dirnaseer Road intersection). Works planned to **commence 23 February 2026** for a period of two weeks. Full traffic management. Expect short delays. Reduced speeds overnight to ensure safety of motorists. Please obey speed signage, drive to conditions.
