**NOTICE TEMPORARY SPEED ZONE ADJUSTMENTS**

**Adjungbilly Area.**

Council hereby gives notice under Section 116 Roads Act that Council is intending on installing a **temporary speed restriction** in the Gobarralong/Adjungbilly Roads area. The proposal includes a speed reduction to 80km/h from the Murrumbidgee River to Adjungbilly Village, 1750m of 60km/h within Adjungbilly Village, 80km/h along the sealed section of Nanangroe Road and 60km/h along the northern 675m of Red Hill Road.

This temporary speed restriction is to ensure safety during a major project within the area and will be in force for 2 years.

**GUNDAGAI RESIDENTS: LEVEL 2 WATER RESTRICTIONS:**

- Fixed hoses & sprinklers banned between restriction times – 9am to 6pm.
- Fixed hoses & sprinklers to be on a timer.
- Washing of vehicles on lawns with a hose permitted provided the use of a trigger cut off nozzle.
- Hosing of paths & driveways banned.
- Water runoff onto roads or gutters banned.

**Please note:** Stage 3 Water restrictions may be implemented into the future if the storage in Blowering & Burrinjuck Dams fall below 20% or water allocation is reduced to 50%.

**DEVELOPMENT APPLICATION ON PUBLIC EXHIBITION:**

CGRC has received Development Application DA No. 2019/143.7 (PAN-598802) from Habitat Planning Wagga Pty Ltd for land at multiple lots on Tumblong Reserve Road, Tumblong NSW 2590. The application is for a **Regionally Significant & Integrated Development**, being a **Section 4.55(2) modification** to an approved waste management facility, proposing to increase annual landfill capacity from **60,000 tonnes to 99,000 tonnes**. The application & supporting documents will be on public exhibition on the **NSW Planning Portal from 4 Feb to 6 Mar 2026**. Submissions may be made via the Portal or in writing to Council, quoting **DA No. 2019/143.7, by 5pm Fri, 6 Mar 2026**. Objections must clearly state reasons. Submissions may be included in public reports & accessed under the **GIPA Act 2009**. Disclosure of any reportable political donations or gifts is required under relevant planning legislation.
