### GUNDAGAI RESIDENTS: LEVEL 2 WATER RESTRICTIONS:

- Fixed hoses & sprinklers banned between restriction times – 9am to 6pm.
  - Fixed hoses & sprinklers to be on a timer.
  - Washing of vehicles on lawns with a hose permitted provided the use of a trigger cut off nozzle.
  - Hosing of paths & driveways banned.
  - Water runoff onto roads or gutters banned.
- Please note:** Stage 3 Water restrictions may be implemented into the future if the storage in Blowering & Burrinjuck Dams fall below 20% or water allocation is reduced to 50%.
