### DEMERGER NEWS & NEXT MEETING:

Council is required by the Office of Local Government to demonstrate the financial sustainability of the two proposed successor councils. On 16 June, the Demerger Transition Committee approved the appointment of Peter Tegart (Always Thinking Advisory) to update the Financial Sustainability Plan originally prepared for Council’s submissions to the Public Inquiry & Boundaries Commission. Mr Tegart will also prepare Long-Term Financial Plans & Revenue Policies for each successor council, key components of the Integrated Planning framework.

### ROAD WORKS:

**Drainage construction works** along Olney Street, Cootamundra have commenced. **Work hours will be 7:00am to 5pm Monday to Friday & 7am to 3pm Saturday.** Temporary traffic control & minor delays may occur. Some noise; dust, & general construction activity should be expected.

**Line marking works** will commence on 25 June 2026 along Old Gundagai Road, Killrush Road, Callinga Road, Berthong Road & Dirnaseer Road, as well as selected intersections within the Cootamundra Township, weather permitting. Temporary traffic control will be in place; minor delays may occur. Council apologises for any inconvenience.

### MUNDARLO BRIDGE REPLACEMENT:

Works are expected to begin in late June (weather permitting) on Tenandra Road. Motorists should proceed with caution, expect delays & follow traffic signals. The project includes a new 110-metre bridge, 3.7 metres higher, with wider dual lanes for heavy vehicles. Completion is expected December 2026.
