ROAD WORKS:

Drainage construction works along Olney Street, Cootamundra. **Work hours will be 7:00am to 5pm Monday to Friday & 7am to 3pm Saturday.** Temporary traffic control & minor delays may occur.

FIRE HYDRANT INSPECTION & MAINTENANCE PROGRAM:

Council will begin a fire hydrant inspection & maintenance program to help maintain a safe & reliable water supply network. Approximately **800 hydrants in Cootamundra & 400 in Gundagai & South Gundagai** will be inspected, tested, flushed & maintained as required. While disruption will be kept to a minimum, hydrant flushing may occasionally cause temporary water discolouration due to disturbed sediment. If this occurs, residents are advised to **run a cold water tap for several minutes until the water clears.**

BIOSECURITY NOTICE: OPUNTIOD CACTUS

Common Pear, an opuntiod cactus, is present in the LGA. The plant has 1.5 cm spines & barbed detachable bristles, are injurious to humans & animals. Currently regulated with the General Biosecurity Duty, landholders must prevent, eliminate or minimise any associated biosecurity risk. Biocontrol options are available. ROAD CLOSED: ADAMS STREET COOTAMUNDRA:

Adams Street between Cutler Avenue & Northcott Avenue is closed to all traffic due to safety concerns over the deteriorating causeway. The closure is expected to remain in place for **approximately six months** while repair works are completed. Vehicles under 4 tonnes should use the detour via **Cutler Avenue & Northcott Avenue.**
