FIRE HYDRANT INSPECTION & MAINTENANCE PROGRAM:

 Council is undertaking a fire hydrant inspection & maintenance program across Cootamundra, Gundagai. More than **1,200 hydrants** will be tested, flushed & maintained to help ensure a safe & reliable water supply. Residents may notice temporary water discolouration during flushing. If this occurs, run a cold tap for a few minutes until the water clears.

WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT PROGRAM GUNDAGAI:

DEVELOPMENT NOTIFICATION CHANGES NOW IN EFFECT:

The NSW Government's new Statewide Community Participation Plan has replaced local council plans, changing how Development Applications are notified across NSW. Under the new rules, public exhibition or neighbour notification of many lower-impact developments, including new homes, alterations & additions, dual occupancies, secondary dwellings & subdivisions of up to five lots, will no longer occur. Council cannot reinstate the previous notification process, & residents should not assume no application has been lodged nearby if they do not receive a notification.
